WHO RECOGNIZES THE SQF PROGRAM?

The SQF Program is endorsed by the Global Food Safety Initiative (GFSI), an organization representing over 70% of food retail revenue worldwide.

SQF Certification is supported by an increasing number of U.S. and international retailers, many of whom are expressing a preference for SQF-certified suppliers. In addition, the SQF standard is part of a recent landmark agreement on mutual acceptance of global food safety systems by seven major global retailers – Ahold, Carrefour, Tesco, Migros, Metro, Wal-Mart and Delhaize.
